Animal	Daniel 7:17, 23	King or Kingdom	
Woman	Ephesians 5:23-32	Church / God's People	That is a very recurring allegory in prophetic and wisdom texts on the OT Also allusion to it on the NT are frequent. So, pure women symbolizes a church which is faithful to Christ. A whore, an unfaithful church.
Water	Revelation 17:15	People/Populations	The symbolism implies that many waters are a lot of people (or a densely populated area) and desert (a place with very little or no water) means a place scarcely populated.
1 Day	Ezekiel 4:6-7 and Number 14:34	1 Year	On the Hebrew Bible, usually to make easier and not only dependent on the context (or the interpreter) to discern when a day should be take as literal or prophetic, the writers went to high pains to make easy the reader to identify the symbolism by the number and the object (for example, instead of writing "1 day", which means 1 literal, 24h day, they would write "day 1" to signify prophetic period corresponding to 1 literal year.

Times	Daniel 11:13	Prophetic Years	In Biblical times, the year was, general, a 360 days year. Therefore, a prophetic year correspond to 360 literal/calendar years (one literal year for each of the 360 prophetic days of the prophetic year).
